A rival once tried to discredit him in front of al-Muḥammad by saying that al-Ḥasan had read only six of the thirteen books of Euclid's Elements. Al-Ḥasan replied by saying that it was unnecessary for him to read the remainder because he could arrive at the answers to any of Euclid's problems by deduction. Al-Muḥammad acknowledged al-Ḥasan's skill, but did not excuse him, saying: laziness has prevented you from reading the whole of it—it is to geometry as the letters a, b, t, 111 are to speech and writing. (H. 264). Al-Ḥasan is rarely mentioned by name elsewhere in the sources and may have preferred to devote his time to scholarship, whereas his brothers were involved in a variety of undertakings.
